EDUCATIONAL EVENT:

- Every exhibit has workshops that are taught by individuals or groups of artists in the show.
- Artists receive 70% of the revenue generated from enrollment fees for the educational event.
- If you are interested in conducting a workshop, please submit your concept, proposed fee for participants, projected cost of supplies and a proposed date with your application for review by the Visual Arts Committee.

SALE OF ARTWORK:

- All artwork must be for sale.
- The artist will receive 70% of all sales, the SSAC will receive a 30% donation on all sales.
- Artists will be paid for sold work within 30 days of the close of show.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Artists may submit one piece of original artwork, made within the last 24 months.
- Size limitations for 2D art is 30"X30" including frame, 3D footprint is 30"X30".
- All artwork must be wired and ready for gallery hanging and presentation.
- Artist may submit two pieces of shrink wrapped, labeled bin work, max 20"X24", max price \$200.
- This show will require the participation of all artists to help produce the exhibit.
- All works will be insured while on the premises for 70% of the stated price of the work.
- Pieces must remain on display through the end of the show unless they are sold and a comparable replacement is available.
