The show represents 30 years of kinship, adventure and masterworks by four of the leading western plein air and landscape artists today: Oberg, Smith, Whitcomb and Young.
- Choose a piece of art and make your own interpretation of the masters work. Your piece can be any medium you like.
- Title your piece with the original Artist’s title and any title you care to add. List medium, measurements (height x width) and price.

Sale of Artwork

- All artwork should be ready to hang or display.
- All artwork must be for sale.
- Steamboat Creates retains 30% commission on all sales.
- Exhibitors will be paid for sold work within 30 days of the close of the show.
