JUDGED SHOW:

The Western Heritage Show at the Depot and in participating galleries will be judged by a committee of no less than three community members. Please supply a high resolution jpeg for judging process.

Best in show will be given a gift certificate for a cowboy hat and boots (up to \$400 value) from FM Light & Sons.

2nd place will receive a one-year Affiliate Membership in Steamboat Creates.

3rd place will receive a one-year Artist Membership in Steamboat Creates.

Prizes will be awarded at the CCI Summit reception Thursday night, September 30.

- Artists may submit 1 piece of original artwork, made within the last 24 months.
- All artwork must be wired and ready for gallery

hanging and presentation, or ready for display.

- Artists may submit 2 pieces of shrink wrapped or smaller items labeled bin work, max price \$150. These will not be part of the competition and need to be labeled with Name, title and price.
- **For your work to be considered for judging purposes please send a hi-resolution jpeg image to barb@steamboatcreates.org.**

Show Requirements:

- All work will be insured while on the premises for 70% of the stated price.
- Entries may not be removed before the end of the show except in approved circumstances.
- Steamboat Creates reserves the right to final curatorial, educational, publicity and installation decisions.
- This show will require the participation of all artists to help produce the exhibit.
- All artists are required to bring food, participate in social marketing and attend reception, Friday, October 2, 5pm–8pm

Sale of Artwork:

- All artwork must be for sale.
- Steamboat Creates retains 30% commission on all sales.
- Exhibitors will be paid for sold work within 30 days of the close of the show.
- A W-9 form needs to be turned in with this application to insure payment to the artist.

Return of Artwork:

I will pick up my artwork on Tuesday, November 2 unless by prior arrangement.

I will require and pay for the return shipment of my unsold work.

Submission of this application constitutes an agreement with all conditions of this show.
