x	1	Nozcaboose	Espartaco Albornoz Abreu	Depot Art Center - Caboose	Espartaco, originally from Venezuela, now a Brooklyn-based street artist and creator of the Nozco. Nozco is a childishly drawn human figure not representative of any gender. Tapping into the concepts of purity and play.
x	2	Colorado Rocky Mountains	Dan Toro	Yampa Valley Brewing Hop House	Colors of the CO logo provide a recognizable symbolizing the geographical features, abundant sunshine, snow-capped mountains and clear blue skies for Dan's mural at this location.
x	3	Untitled	Dan Benjamin	Seedz	Dan is a freelance artists who has worked in kitchens for the majority of his more than 20 years in the Yampa Valley. His Seedz mural adds a bright spot and unique visual content to the large space.
x	4	Mule Deer	Bobby MaGee Lopez	Meat and Seafood Company	An accomplished muralist doing large scale installations in urban areas like Denver, Boulder and beyond. Bobby depicts a mule deer with warm tones and repetitive pattern reflective of similar patterns you might find in native weavings.
x	5	Portal to Imagination	Greg Effinger	Off the Beaten Path Bookstore	Born and raised in Steamboat, Greg Effinger's artwork is often inspired by familiar Colorado landscapes and contemporary activities that make Colorado special. This mural contains real and imaginary elements that provides a glimpse into his world.
x	6	Yampa is Wild	Jill Bergman	Routt County Search and Rescue (river side)	With a background in printmaking, Jill's first mural is a collaboration with Friends of the Yampa capturing the 250 mile long river into a 850 square foot mural that wraps two sides of the building. Conceived as a community project, many volunteers painted elements of the flora and fauna, ecosystem and recreational use of the mighty Yampa.
x	7	Echoes of the West	Dan Toro	8th Street Steakhouse (alley)	A Wyoming artist channeling his love of authentic western spirit as represented in the buffalo and cowboy silhouette.
x	8	Wings	Jeff Roth	Kali's Boutique	Jeff, a beloved teacher, his interactive Wing mural allows the participant to insert themselves into the artist's painting. Capturing a special moment in a special place was the driving force for this piece.
x	9	Untitled	Fernando Maldonado	Mambo Italiano (alley)	Fernando practices creativity in many of his endeavors. He worked in the kitchen at Mambo Italiano, when the owner of the restaurant asked him to create this daytime scene of life in old town, featuring a special little house found on Pine Street.
x	10	The Cowgirl	ARCY	Colorado Group Realty Building (alley)	Ryan Christenson, known as ARCY, paints murals across the country every summer. He completed this spray painted mural, start to finish, in two days. His inspiration came from a photograph from a local ranch.
x	11	Yampa River Flow	Jeff Roth	Natural Grocers (alley)	The largest mural in town, Yampa River Flow, captures the river flowing beneath the setting sun. The concept was developed after exploring relationships between the customer, the artist and the community. Jeff explores many modes of creativity to engage in meaningful ways with the people and place of Steamboat Springs.
x	12	Bike Town USA	Chula Beauregard	Ski and Bike Kare	Chula Beauregard is a sixth-generation Coloradan. Her paintings are often inspired by the Western landscape, creating a sense of place. This piece acknowledges a frenzy of ways people enjoy the Rocky Mountains.
x	13	Fiesta for Salvador	Fernando Maldonado	Old Town Pub	Fernando created this mural as a memorial to Salvador Mendoza, a dancer and choreographer in Steamboat Dance Theatre. His infectious smile brought so much joy to everyone that knew him.
x	14	Café Terrace at Night	Dona Steele	Deja Vu Building stairs and retaining wall	A practicing artist, Dona Steele has over 35 years teaching experience including Steamboat Creates, Steamboat Art Museum and Collier County Public School System. This little niche painting was inspired by Van Gogh's "Cafe Terrace at Night".
x	15	Elevate Arts	Greg Block	Aspen Botanical Building (alley)	Gregory Block, a nationally-acclaimed Denver-based artist who grew up in Steamboat, said painting his first mural was an emotional experience. Block was named "one of the most promising young artists in the representational art world" by <i>Fine Art Today</i> . His mural "Elevate" was inspired by the music and arts he was exposed to during his childhood in Steamboat.
x	16	The Great Outdoors	Ben Rock and Greg Effinger	Straightline Sports (alley)	Designed by Ben Rock and painted by Greg Effinger, this mural captures the energy of outdoor recreation and wildlife people encounter in the area.
s	17	Forest Adventurous	Lance Whitner	Pine Moon Building (alley)	Forrest Adventurous became a community event where Lance invited painters of all ages to help her complete this mural. A playful representation of trees and flowers and grasses found in the surrounding mountains and trails.
x	18	America the Beautiful	Bobby MaGee Lopez	Veterans of Foreign War (alley)	The Americana theme was a good fit for the alleyway of the Veteran's Center in downtown Steamboat. Bobby is a Denver based artist who paints murals across the nation.
